## TARRY. Frederick BUGBROOKE

It is believed that Frederick Tarry was principally a carrier but in the circa 1926-30 period he provided a bus service between Bugbrooke, Kislingbury and Northampton, terminating at the yard of the Woolpack Inn in Bridge Street.

Tarry is said to have run a Fiat bus but no trace of this has been found. However, he certainly bought a Ford registered RP 3344 on 7th October 1926 and this was licensed for dual hackney/goods use. Evidently Tarry decided not to apply for a Road Service Licence when the Road Traffic Act, 1930 became law.
