## DAINTY. John T. Red House, GEDDINGTON

John Dainty was born in 1876 and became a carrier in 1910, based in Geddington, where carrying goods in the locality became his principal business. However, in 1922, he bought a 14 seater Model T Ford with which he operated a bus service to Kettering. It is likely that the vehicle was also used in connection with his carriers business and by about 1924 it seems that John Dainty let the vehicle out on hire to a Mr W Tinker of Kettering. Tinker used it for private hires until it was burnt out in February 1925. No evidence has been uncovered to suggest that John Dainty operated passenger vehicles after 1924.
