

THE OMNIBUS SOCIETY : LONDON HISTORICAL RESEARCH GROUPINDEX TO GROUP BULLETIN : VOLUME 1, NUMBERS 62 to 67F O R E W O R D

Two previous volumes of Index have been produced covering Issues 1 to 50 and 51 to 61. As stated in the Foreword to the last Index, it was intended to continue to produce an index every two years, covering twelve issues. However, in 1984 the Bulletin changed to a quarterly publication and the opportunity was taken to commence a new volume (2) with pagination reverting to 1, having reached 539 at the end of Bulletin 67. It was decided, therefore, to produce a further volume of index to complete Volume 1.

A sad event has also affected the production of this index. The initiator and compiler of the previous index volumes, Albert W. McCall, died in May 1984. 'Mac' had at the time indexed Bulletin 62 and it was left to the present compiler to continue the task. Before I did so I made a careful study of the previous indexes to enable, as far as possible, a similar style and approach so as not to confuse the user. I hope that I have succeeded, but if in my indexing idiosyncracies show through, I can only apologise.

NOTES ON THE INDEX AND HOW TO USE IT

As stated above, I have tried to follow the method and format of the previous volumes and therefore the notes published in the introduction to those volumes apply equally to this. The items quote the page numbers on which they appear and pages covered by each Bulletin are shown in the List of Issues which follows. If an item appears more than once on a page the number of times it appears is shown in brackets alongside the page number, e.g. 516(3). The alphabetisation used is on the 'all through' principle e.g. ST-type buses comes after Stroud Green.

Larger subjects, such as London General Omnibus Company, are shown as headings in their alphabetical place, with special matters listed beneath as in previous volumes.

London bus routes are dealt with within the three distinctive periods used before, these being

- (1) from 1908 to 1924;
- (2) from 1925 to October 1934 (the 'Bassom' period);
- (3) from October 1934 to the present time.

Postal districts, or area for those outside the London Postal District, have been appended to street names to aid identification.

In a work of this nature, it is possible there are errors and omissions, although every effort has been made to keep these to a minimum. The Convenors would be grateful if these, together with any suggestions for the improvement of future index volumes could be brought to the attention of the compiler, Mr. D. A.
