## ANDERSON. Henry FARTHINGHOE

On 6th September 1920 a 30 horsepower Ford T registered in Oxfordshire as BW 3368 was transferred to Henry Anderson of Farthinghoe. It was described as a "small bus", was painted blue and seated ten passengers. For some reason it was not listed as a public conveyance in the Northamptonshire registration records so whether Anderson used his Ford as a bus, which it was on acquisition, or as a van remains obscure.
