Knowledge of Norman Ayres as a bus operator would not have come to light had this proprietor not transgressed the vehicle licensing laws in some minor way in July 1930. As the saying goes, "be sure your sins will find you out" and Norman Ayres' sins disclosed that he was running LN 5178 as a Hackney Carriage at this time, when he was also described as a Bus Proprietor.

When Norman Ayres commenced trading and what his operation were is difficult to say but he must have ceased his business shortly after 1930 as he was not licensed by the Traffic Commissioners under the 1930 Road Traffic Act.
