## GOTCH, H.G. Chesham House KETTERING

Another operator about whom virtually nothing is known was H G Gotch of Chesham House, Kettering. He did however own a brown Sunbeam with coach seats that was also used as a lorry. This machine was registered BD 680 and is thought to have dated from about 1919/20. No evidence has come to light of Mr Gotch being granted licences that would have enabled him to operate local bus services, so it is presumed that his passenger carrying activities were confined to private hires.
