Both timetable sheets refer to the previous operator as: (Late ROAD MOTORS, Ltd.). The books in this table continued to be titled NOTC, Luton & District until May 1930 but had red covers only until February 1930. From March to May they had green covers. June 1930 was the first to be titled 'Eastern National Omnibus Company, Luton & District' but still with an NOTC-style green cover. From July to December 1930, books had a new style cover with a bus picture and were titled 'Eastern National Omnibus Company, Luton Area'.

Table 8A London Transport area timetable books 1934 to 1937

The London area was defined as all territory within a line which enclosed Woolwich, Abbey Wood, Eltham, Grove Park, Beckenham, West Wickham, Croydon, North Cheam, Kingston, Twickenham, Hounslow, Southall, Greenford, Sudbury, Kenton, Hendon, Whetstone, Chingford, Ilford, Becontree, Dagenham. Places outside that line were: Erith, Welling, Sidcup, Bromley, Keston, Purley, Sutton, Hampton Court, Hayes, Harrow, Mill Hill, High Barnet, Enfield, Chigwell, Romford, Rainham. The boundary between the SE and SW area was a line with Keston and Westerham to the east of it, and Warlingham, Chelsham, Limpsfield, Oxted and Edenbridge to the west. The boundary between the SW and W areas was a line close to the River Thames with Hampton Court and Chertsey to the south of it and with Shepperton, Staines, Egham and Virginia Water to the north. The boundary between the W and NW areas was a line with Hayes, Ruislip, Gerrards Cross, High Wycombe and Penn to the south of it and Harrow, Northwood, Rickmansworth and Amersham to the north. The boundary between the NW and NE areas was a line with Mill Hill, Colney Heath, Wheathampstead and Luton to the west of it, and High Barnet, Welham Green, Hatfield, Kimpton, King's Walden and Hitchin to the east. The boundary between the NE and SE areas was the River Thames with Rainham and Grays to the north of it and Erith, Dartford and Gravesend to the south. See also the notes in the LBUT Supplement.
