A short-lived Kettering venture by a person or persons unknown was the operation of what was probably a charabanc named “The Montagu”.

All that is known of this operation is that which is contained in the advertisement appended that originally was placed in the Kettering Evening Telegraph of Friday 4th August 1922. Trips to Hunstanton, Bedford and Leamington were proposed and that seems to have been the end of the matter.

Possibly further research on whose Works were situated in Montagu Street, Kettering in 1922 might elicit the identity of this operator.
