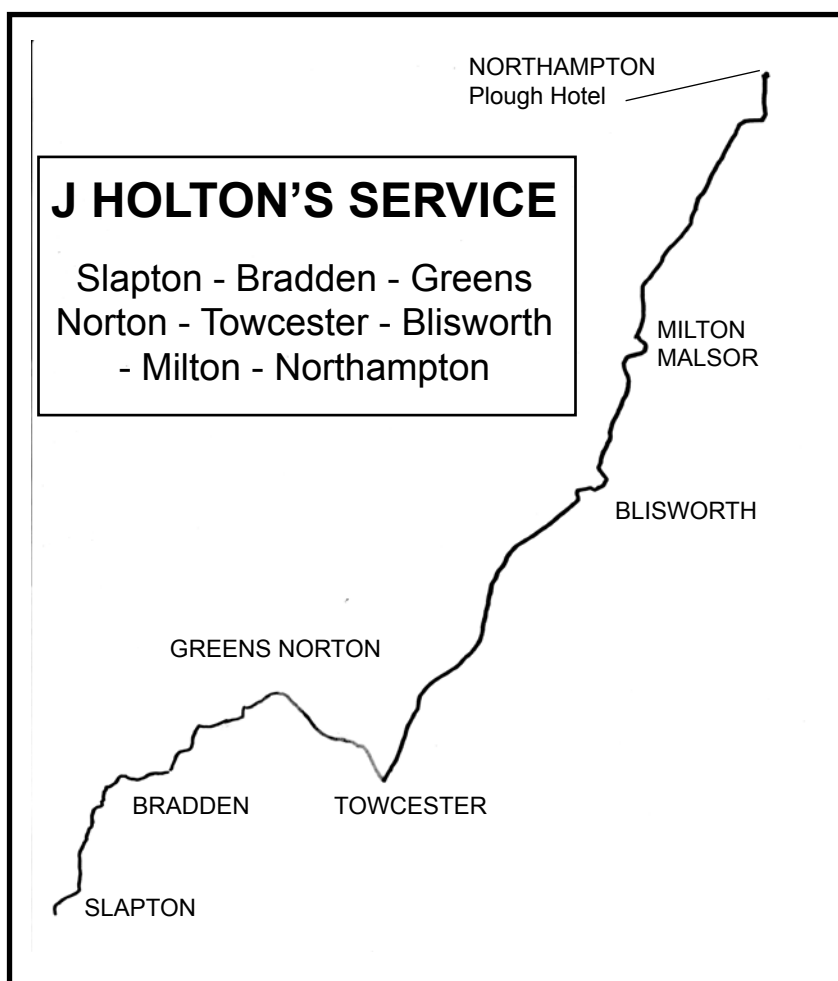

## HOLTON. J. BRADDEN

The little that is remembered of this operator is that circa 1925 he started a Slapton - Bradden - Greens Norton - Towcester - Blisworth - Milton - Northampton (Plough Hotel) service using a Ford T fourteen-seater bus that he bought from C E Billington of Northampton (NN-BI2) and sold it a year later to C H Chinn of Towcester (NN-CH5). The Ford carried a blue and white livery but otherwise its identity is unknown.
