Page 39 23.02.1913	68	Daily	The original compilers' source for stating that buses ran via Hinton Road is not known, and given the low railway bridge in that road it is questionable. Maps are insufficiently precise. It is much more likely that buses followed the route known to have been used in later years from Coldharbour Lane via Herne Hill Road and Wanless Road to Milkwood Road.
Page 57 17.07.1913	94	Sun- Fri nights	Amend date for introduction of this route to 14/15.07.1913
Page 69 19.10.1913	82	Daily	Insert 'Sundays' between 'on' and 'between'.

Page 75 Amend Tuesday 31st December 1913 to Wednesday 31st December 1913.

Page 96 Amend note to read:

NOTE: L.G.O.C. Bus Maps for July and August 1914 show Thursday and Saturday operation on route 101 to Lambourne End and Thursday and Saturday operation on route 157 to High Beach but there is nothing on record cards to indicate these extensions operated.
