No information has come to light on this operator other than that on 18th February 1920 he bought a twenty-five horsepower International thirty-five hundredweight lorry that was painted lead gray but was also used for the conveyance of the public. It was registered BD 4130.

This machine was still in use in dual-purpose form by Sadler in February 1922 but sometime after that passed to William Knight of Walgrave and was last licensed in July 1926.
