Little Irchester

It is not at all clear that Mrs Gilbey of Little Irchester was a bus operator at all although she acquired UT 5128 a Thornycroft A6 saloon bus during the War in June 1941. It seems possible that she belonged to a Showman's family and that the vehicle concerned was used as living quarters until June 1947 when it was scrapped.
