WESTLEY. William Charles 17 Brunswick Street NORTHAMPTON

In all probability William Charles Westley operated taxis only and may never have owned a bus. He was operating in the 1917 to 1919 period when he was granted Hackney Carriage Licences by Northampton County Borough Council, but records in these instances do not differentiate between taxis and buses.

Westley was in business for some time and he is listed in Mark's 1928 Directory as being a Cab, Taxi and Motor Car Proprietor.

The only vehicle noted to have been operated by William Charles Westley was NH 2561 which was a sixteen horsepower Crossley registered in February 1920, although many Crossleys of this period were former military vehicles and consequently a little older.
