All that has so far been discovered regarding C T Foster of Bakehouse Farm, Potterspury is that on 25th May 1925 he purchased a REO saloon bus which took the registration RP 1153. What he did with it is unknown but he retained it until the end of 1932 suggesting that he ceased operating his REO following the introduction of the Road Traffic Act, 1930.
